We are still looking for committee members to help with the 4th of July. Hanna Sheldon attended the meeting to become a new board member. Cindy Tacha motioned to add Hanna Sheldon to the Board. Allison Arnold seconded. All board members voted yes. Motion passed. For Easter, the board coordinated who would help with the Easter Egg Hunt on April 4th, 2026. Discussion was held on the coordination of how General Meetings are run. It was also discussed that Jess Castle still be a board member. Cindy Tacha motioned that the Chamber keep Jess Castle as a member of the board as a volunteer for Veterans for a Better Community. Allison Arnold seconded the motion. All votes yes. Motion passes. Veterans for a Better Community also explained that they would be hosting a fishing derby at Doug Kissel on June 20th. Corrin Perry brought up the Ranch Rodeo and how much they would like to sponsor for the rodeo. Allison Arnold made a motion to do the 1/8 page. Jess

Castle seconded the motion. All votes yes. Motion passes. Jake Herrera also mentioned the status of the Mtn View Billboards. The Chamber is reaching out to see what rates are like. Kaitey got the new recorder. Kaitey has compiled a list of the members for the Chamber that are still sending checks in and who still needed to be talked to in regard to who still needs to pay.
